

Confirmation Mentor Expectations

As a mentor you are expected to:

- Support and nurture the student throughout the confirmation process.
- Pray for him or her each day.
- Be ready and willing to listen to questions and concerns.
- Get to know them better.
- Read the Gospel of John (your student will be reading it too) and discuss it together.
- Whenever possible connect with your student on Sunday mornings.
- Participate alongside him or her in at least one service project, fundraiser, or other church activity. (If you serve in the church perhaps they could shadow you.)
- Be for him or her an example of an adult Christian with an honest and maturing faith.
- Be willing to discuss and share your own personal faith journey.
- Stand with him or her on April 29 during the Confirmation service and attend reception afterwards.

As a mentor you are not expected to:

- Have all the answers.
- Have a scholarly knowledge of Scripture and Christian theology.
- Be perfect.

For the safety and security of the student and yourself:

- Never meet with him or her alone behind closed doors.
- Don't drive him or her anywhere unless another screened adult or parent is in the car.

Being a mentor to someone can be a life changing experience for both of you. My prayer is that you will be able to start a life-long relationship that will help you both grow in your faith.
