- 522 items of deodorant, sanitizing wipes and other personal care items were donated for the Rescue Mission with a guesstimated value of at least \$1.600!
- \$6,514.25 was given to purchase supplies for a Project 216 food packing event on October 23 and has been added to the \$4,925 collected for Project 216 in 2020 (2020 packing event cancelled due to Covid). A total of \$11,439.25 for Project 216 is now available to purchase food for hungry people.

## News from Michael Agwanda founder and leader of Life for Children Ministry (LCM)



"Greetings in the name of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Kenyan has reported some high numbers in infection of covid-19 lately. They are specifically being spread by politicians who are holding rallies now that next year will be a general election in Kenya. Only about 2% of the population has access vaccine and the rest are still waiting for the vaccine itself that is not available.

As a family, we ask for your prayers and continue being healthy and in ministry. I' got covid-19 and not all is back as I' was expecting. Still have some irregular pulse rates and the doctors are still monitoring the condition.

As a ministry; We are experiencing some financial low time. This is due to so many people that must have been affected with covid-19 as well as my absence from the donors in person for so long due to covid-19. I' plan to travel to the US next year but in the meantime we pray that some of our partners who have not dropped will pray to give significantly to bridge the gap.

Because of covid-19 we have not been doing gathering for street boys feeding program. However we have been on target in building homes for widow. We have done 9 so far since the beginning of the year. We plan to do 12 this year and I' see us blowing the target.

We have just taken kids to school and I' need \$30,000 but was only able to get \$15000 for tuition, school shopping and transport for kids to school. Due to covid-19 the schools only closed for one week and they were back in school for another school calendar year. The ministry of education here is trying to do a catch with out school calendar due to almost a year of covid-19 wasted school time last year.

The ministry is in need of the following now and please pray with us;

- 1. A one classroom block \$15,000
- 2. Furnish a Library and buy books \$10,000
- 3. Paying tuition for the children \$15,000
- 4. Pay a pastor for a whole year \$3500 Any help in this areas will go along way. Be blessed.
