## From the Pastor's Desk

At our Annual Church Meeting a couple of weeks ago I revealed some important initiatives for Covenant UMC for 2023. One you already know about and the other two are related. Let me explain.

In 2023 we are reading the Bible together, we are calling it **Route 66**. The whole Bible, from front to back, Genesis to Revelation, all 66 books (Get it? Route 66?). It only takes about 15-20 minutes a day to read and by the end of the (Christian) year you will have completed the whole thing! That's an accomplishment and one that has great benefits for you and for the whole church. I love reading the scriptures and I encourage you to get started if you haven't yet. Join us on this amazing Biblical journey. Resources are available here and in our bulletin each Sunday.

Related to our Bible Reading Plan is the **WHY...Transformation**. It's not enough to come to church, read the Bible, learn about Jesus, and even participate in a small group. These are all important, but they all have the same goal, our transformation. It's what Jesus is working on in each of us. If we were already perfect, we wouldn't need Him, or each other for that matter. No, we all need transformation. The world needs it, too. So this year I am focused on transforming Covenant UMC and each of us into the church and people Jesus wants us to be. And here's the thing, He's working on me, too. So let's work on this transformation together.

One last thing, transformation doesn't come automatically. It takes effort and time. But most of all it requires prayer. This year I am calling on the whole church to pray for this Transformation every day. I'm inviting you to pray with me for the church like we never have before, every day. So let's commit to reading the scriptures and praying for the power of God to transform this church into what God truly desires.
